In fact, CNN reports that Ghana's capital of Accra (which is 50 miles south of Odumase and impacts its cost of living) is the "priciest place to live in Africa". The Lord in His mercy is providing opportunities for His children to have "something doing" through this small mission. May's payroll for these 32 brothers and sisters was \$1,400 and God provided!
