Parents increasingly share with us the desperate challenges they face in raising their children. Food and clothing are not the concern. Unfortunately, although they are not blaming Western culture, it is the impact of imported movies and music that fuels the youth to disrespect their parents and lose interest in their education. This, combined with continued societal pressure for teen girls to participate in traditional puberty rites administered by fetish priests, is cause for great concern. And yet, these challenges provide a wide-open door for Christ's Co-Mission. Our development of a mission community that courageously honors Christ by trusting Him, loving one another, working hard, and discouraging selfishness by learning how to be a blessing to others seems to have been raised up for such a time as this.
