A new academic year is underway at Loved By Jesus School. By God's grace, we completed last year with 190 students. The Executive Council has approved the addition of a pre-school class which we are now developing. It is our prayer that these young children will come to know that they are truly loved by Jesus and that we will be able to bless their lives. The process of improving our rustic facilities continues as we hope to pour a concrete floor for our 4th grade class (pictured here) very soon. Costs will be about \$250.



In May we completed an additional classroom structure for a total cost of about \$1,600. Below are some photos. After the shipment arrived in June we installed some donated chain-link fencing as walls. Construction of this facility provided much-needed work for seven Ghanaian Christians. Praise God!
